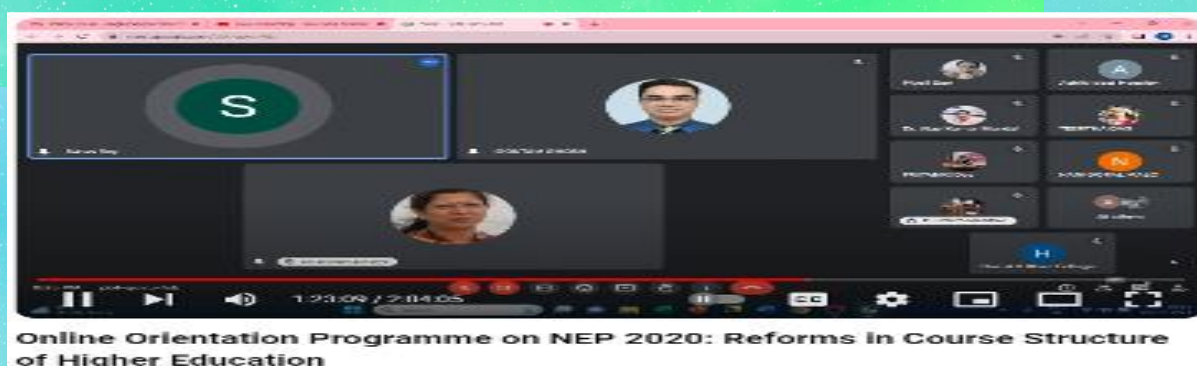

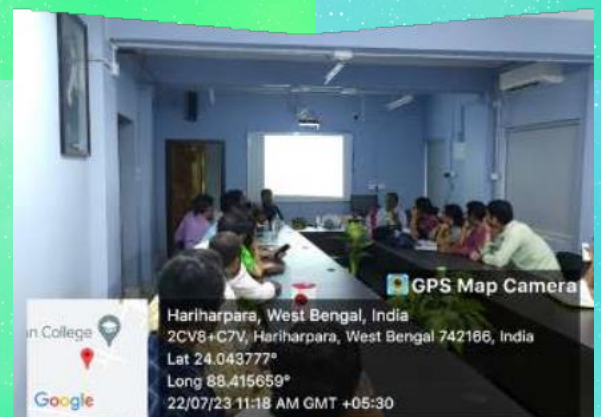

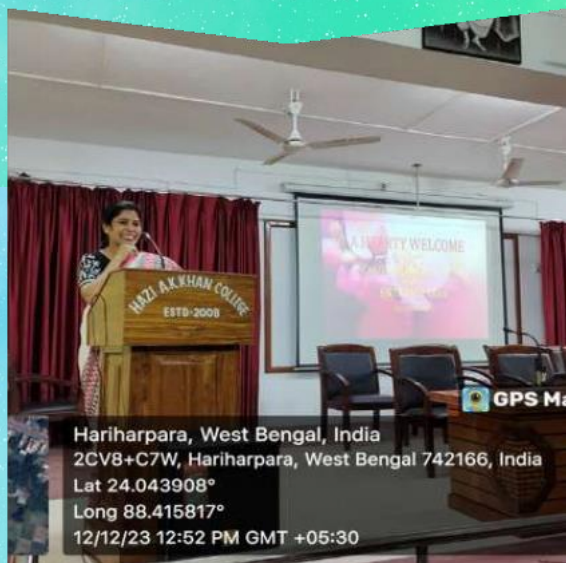

The results highlight significant disparities in health outcomes and access to services between different regions and socio-economic groups. The report concludes with recommendations to improve health services and outcomes for women and children.
