Rokeya Sakhawat Hossain (9 December 1880 – 9 December 1932), commonly known as Begum Rokeya, was a prominent Bengali feminist thinker, writer, educator, professor, teacher and an epitome of women empowerment and political activist for Bengali Muslim girls from undivided Bengal (present-day Bangladesh). She was widely regarded as a pioneer of women's liberation in South Asia. Rokeya is considered as the pioneer feminist of Bengal. She advocated for men and women to be treated equally as rational beings, noting that the lack of education for women was responsible for their inferior economic position. So to propagate 'Women Education in Twenty first Century India', a State Level Seminar on Begum Rokeya will surely justify the issue.
