
#### About the Department

She was widely regarded as a pioneer of women's liberation in South Asia. Rokeya is considered as the pioneer feminist of Bengal .She advocated for men and women to be treated equally as rational beings, noting that the lack of education for women was responsible for their inferior economic position. So to propagate 'Women Education in Twenty first Century India', a state level seminar on Begum Rokeya will surely justify the issue and add a unique flavor to women empowerment.

**Inclusivity**: Ensuring that the lecture is inclusive and addresses the diverse needs and challenges faced by women from various backgrounds can be a challenge.


Engaging Content: Maintaining audience engagement throughout the lecture can be challenging, especially if the content is too academic or lacks practical relevance.
