 Incorporating practical exercises, simulations, or case studies into the seminar could help students apply their knowledge to real-world scenarios.
- Challenges: Ensuring that the seminar is accessible and engaging for students from diverse backgrounds and with varying levels of knowledge on climate change can be challenging. Covering the breadth of the topic adequately within a limited timeframe can be difficult.
